The Ann Arbor Chapter Scholarship Fund was established in 2008 through the generous gift of Ms. Irena Thiel. Up to three scholarships of \$500 are awarded annually to students on a competitive basis following an evaluation of the applicants by the Irena Thiel Scholarship Committee.

Potential candidates can apply only once and are expected to fulfill several general criteria:

1. Residence of the Washtenaw County
2. Current college enrollment
3. Proof of scholastic achievement
4. Involvement in the Polonian activities
5. Community service
