Ann Arbor Polish Film Festival

The Polish Cultural Fund, in partnership with the Polish-American Congress Ann Arbor Chapter and the Polish Language Center of Ann Arbor, invites everyone to the 22nd Ann Arbor Polish Film Festival that will take place on November 13-15 at the Michigan Theatre, Ann Arbor.

This year, the festival program includes five feature films, five documentaries, a short narrative, and a discussion with the festival guest Kinga Dębska. With the young ones in mind, the festival will also include two sessions for children. The program features the latest animations, a family movie, and during the intermission, an exhibit of the best Polish books for children.

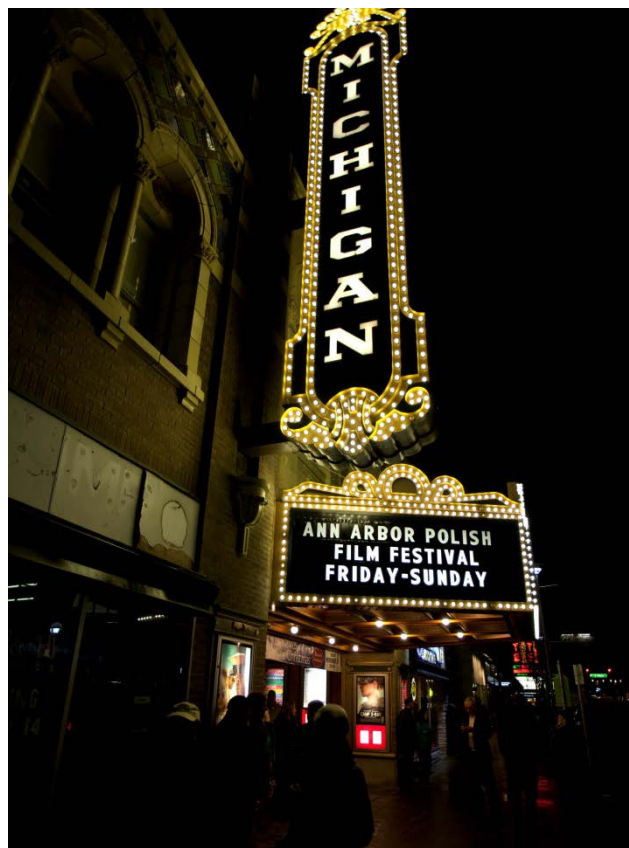
